IMPORTANT - Please note that parking is no longer an included benefit. You must now pay separately for parking. You may purchase a pass for \$60 (B lots) or \$25 (C lot) each semester, or you can simply use the Passport Parking app on your smart phone to pay hourly or daily. It is your choice.
